Greetings,

The Kansas Highway Patrol, as the State Administrative Agency (SAA) for the Homeland Security Grant Programs (HSGP) is pleased to announce that the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has released the FY2022 Nonprofit Security Grant Program funding opportunity, **Funding Opportunity Number** DHS-22-GPD-008-000-01.

The deadline to submit your application packets is no later than **June 1, 2022, by 5:00 PM**. The shortened deadline is due to increased processes required of the SAA to apply on your behalf.

Kansas has been selected to compete for **\$1,800,000.00** for physical security enhancements and other security-related activities to nonprofit organizations that are at high risk of a terrorist attack. It also seeks to integrate the preparedness activities of nonprofit organizations with broader state and local preparedness efforts. This funding opportunity is to address the protection of soft targets/crowded places.

FY 2022 Facts

- Total increased in National funding from 90 to 125 million dollars.
 - This means more nonprofits have an opportunity for funding with a well justified application
- The Investment Justification form (IJ) previously used has been revised and attached.
 - If you began using the old IJ, please transpose the information over to the new form before submission.
- Eligibility requirements apply

- If you receive *any* public tax dollars to operate- you do not qualify- eligibility links can be located on <http://www.datacounts.net/nsgp>
- The *facility* you are applying for must be completed (not under construction), occupied and operational by the time of application and located in Kansas.
 - This opportunity is not for building a new facility nor is it for cemeteries and is strictly for security enhancements
- Bonus points will be given to new applicants/organizations
- Bonus points will be given for Underserved Communities

What you need to apply:

Determine your eligibility

Obtain a Unique Identifier Number through www.SAM.gov

And submit the following documents in your application packet to the SAA by June 1, 2022, 5:00 PM:

1. NSGP IJ (attached)

- Nonprofit subapplicants with one site may apply for up to \$150,000 for that site.
- Nonprofit subapplicants with multiple sites may apply for up to \$150,000 per site, for up to three sites, for a maximum of 450,000 per nonprofit subapplicant. If a nonprofit subapplicant applies for multiple sites, it must submit one complete IJ for *each* site.

The IJ (attached) must describe each investment proposed for funding.

Nonprofit subapplicants are required to *self-identify* with one of the following four categories in the IJ as part of the application process:

1. Ideology-based/Spiritual/Religious
2. Educational
3. Medical
4. Other

2. Vulnerability/Risk Assessment (NSGP-S and NSGP-UA only)

Each nonprofit subapplicant must include a vulnerability/risk assessment **unique to the site** the IJ is being submitted for.

3. Mission Statement (NSGP-S and NSGP-UA only)

Each nonprofit subapplicant must include its Mission Statement and any mission implementation policies or practices that may elevate the organization's risk.

Incomplete or late application packets received after June 1, 2022, by 5:00 PM will not be considered.
