

Application Information for the
Nonprofit Security Grant Program
in the State of Kansas



Program Overview:

The Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) is funded through the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS)/ Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and is administered by the Kansas Highway Patrol (KHP), which serves as the State's Administrative Agency (SAA).

The NSGP provides funding support for physical security enhancements and other security activities to nonprofit organizations that are at substantial risk of a terrorist attack.

Eligibility:

- The SAA is the only organization that can apply for NSGP funds on behalf of eligible nonprofits at high risk of terrorist attack.
- Eligible nonprofits must be 501(c)(3) organizations and tax-exempt under section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Examples of eligible entities may include nonprofits such as, but are not limited to:

- ✓ Houses of Worship
- ✓ Nonprofit Education Facilities
- ✓ Nonprofit Medical Facilities
- ✓ Other 501(c)(3) organizations

- Nonprofits in the Kansas City Metro counties of Johnson, Leavenworth, and Wyandotte must apply through Missouri.

- 1** Obtain a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI)
Apply for your UEI at www.SAM.gov

- 2** Conduct a Vulnerability/Risk Assessment
If you cannot schedule an on-site risk assessment, you can utilize a self risk assessment, or contact us directly for assistance.
- 3** Submit the Following Documents:
 - Organizational Mission Statement
 - Vulnerability/Risk Assessment
 - Investment Justification (IJ), *the grant application form*
